



## UTI Housing Grant Program 2017-2018

### Universal Technical Institute/NASCAR Technical Institute Motorcycle and Marine Mechanics Institute Information Sheet

#### **Objective:**

To provide grants for housing costs incurred through Collegiate Housing Services by relocating students enrolled at \*UTI/MMI/NASCAR Technical Institute, who show financial need and who reflect a true commitment to converting their passion into a career as a professional technician (based on the criteria outlined below). The grant will support enrolled relocating students with the greatest financial need who face a hardship starting their education. This grant is only available for students relocating more than 50 miles, and is available to cover the deposit, first month's rent, pro-rated rent amount at move-in, and service fee up to a maximum amount of \$1,000. (Grant cannot be used to cover application fee, pet deposits, or other costs not listed here.) This grant is available to incoming students utilizing the shared or connect\* housing options offered through Collegiate Housing Services.

\*The connect housing option is only available to students attending MMI located in Arizona or Florida.

#### **Criteria for awarding the scholarship:**

Enrolled relocating students who meet all other admissions requirements for Universal Technical Institute, NASCAR Technical Institute, Motorcycle Mechanics Institute or Marine Mechanics Institute, and all the criteria below, may apply for the UTI Housing Grant.

#### **Students must:**

- Be enrolled to begin training at a \*UTI/MMI/NASCAR Technical Institute campus.
- Reflect financial need based on information provided by a completed FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). For questions on the completion or approval of your FAFSA, call your campus Financial Aid Department.
- Be relocating more than 50 miles to attend \*UTI/MMI/NSACAR Technical Institute.
- Participate in the shared housing option through Collegiate Housing Services
- Participate in the connect housing option through Collegiate Housing Services – only available to students attending MMI in Arizona or Florida.
- Submit the UTI Housing Grant Application to the UTI Scholarship Department prior to their start date in order to be considered for this grant. We encourage you to submit your application as soon as possible as funds are limited; and at least 45 days prior to your start date, to ensure funds are available.

#### **Process and Rules:**

Students must complete an application and submit it to the UTI Scholarship Department prior to their start date. All eligible applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarship Committee, and all applicants will be notified within seven (7) business days of receipt. **This grant is ONLY available to incoming students. Students already attending classes are ineligible to apply.** Applications may be submitted to the Scholarship Department any time after applicants FAFSA has been completed, and prior to move-in.

#### **Program Disclaimers:**

The UTI Housing Grant cannot be used in conjunction with the UTI Institutional Grant. Students eligible for both must choose which grant they would like to utilize. Students must complete an application and submit it to the UTI Scholarship Department. The applications received will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Students who apply and meet all requirements will be considered for this grant.

Of those viable applications, the awards will be distributed on a first come, first serve basis; limited funds are available for this grant program. All viable applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarship Committee. Students must be enrolled to attend Universal Technical Institute, NASCAR Technical Institute, Motorcycle Mechanics Institute, or Motorcycle and Marine Mechanics Institute at the time of application submission. Grants awarded are not transferable to any other person. All awards granted through the UTI Housing Grant Program can only be used during the initial enrollment; any unutilized funds cannot be applied to a secondary enrollment.

The UTI Housing Grant is available to incoming students utilizing the shared or connect\* housing options offered through Collegiate Housing Services. Award amount not to exceed \$1,000. These funds will be paid directly to Collegiate Housing Services.

\*The connect housing option is only available to students attending MMI located in Arizona or Florida.

This grant cannot be used in conjunction with the UTI Institutional Grant.
