



## Houston MSAT Relocation Grant 2022-2023

### Universal Technical Institute Grant Information Sheet

#### **Objective:**

To provide grants for housing costs incurred through Collegiate Housing Services for students who are currently attending, or previously graduated from a Universal Technical Institute campus located outside of Houston, TX or NASCAR Technical Institute that wish to relocate to the Houston, TX campus in order to further their education by enrolling in one of the following MSAT programs: BMW Fast Track program, Cummins Engines Advanced Training program, or Ford FACT program. This grant will support enrolled relocating students who meet the criteria outlined below. This grant will only be available for housing secured through Collegiate Housing Services, and will cover the applicant's service fee, deposit (if applicable) and rent for the basic shared housing unit for the duration of the program, not to exceed 15 weeks. In addition, grant recipients will receive a check in the amount of \$100 to assist with the cost of relocation. Student is responsible for the Application Fee charged through Collegiate Housing Services.

#### **Criteria for awarding grant:**

This Grant in Aid is available to applicants who previously attended, are currently attending, or scheduled to attend a Universal Technical Institute campus located outside of Houston, TX or NASCAR Technical Institute, and have a desire to further their education by enrolling in one of the specified MSAT programs listed below that are offered at Universal Technical Institute located in Houston, TX. All applicants must meet all of the criteria outlined below to be eligible to apply:

#### **Students must:**

- Be currently enrolled or a graduate from one of the Universal Technical Institute campuses located outside of Houston, TX, or NASCAR Technical Institute
- Meet all enrollment requirements of the manufacturer specific advanced training program that they are enrolling into
- Enrolled to begin one of the MSAT programs listed below at Universal Technical Institute located in Houston, TX no later than September 30, 2023
  - BMW Fast Track program
  - Cummins Engines Advanced Training program
  - Ford FACT program
- Be eligible for housing through Collegiate Housing Services

#### **Process and Rules:**

The Houston MSAT Relocation Grant is only available for students who require relocation for an MSAT program that is not currently offered at their existing campus. Exceptions to this rule will only be made for MSAT programs (located at student's existing campus) that are at full capacity and can no longer take new students. This grant cannot be used in conjunction with any other internal UTI scholarship, grant or tuition reduction program during enrollment to the Universal Technical Institute campus located in Houston, TX (i.e., Industry's Choice Scholarship, Salute to Service Grant, Elective Scholarship). Only one award will be given per student. Applicants will need to complete an application and submit it to the UTI Scholarship Department. The applications received will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Students who apply and meet all requirements will be considered for this grant. With the exception of the \$100 check given to student, this grant is paid directly to Collegiate Housing Services and is applied towards the student's housing costs.

If a student fails to graduate with the required GPA or changes start date or campus, his/her grant may be forfeited. Any grants awarded are not transferable to any other person. If a student chooses not to attend Universal Technical Institute in Houston, TX or after beginning their program chooses to leave for any reason (withdrawal, suspended, terminated), they will forfeit the Houston MSAT Relocation Grant immediately and will be responsible for any remaining costs incurred through Collegiate Housing Services.

Such a suspension will not affect awards to students who are awarded a grant under this program prior to the suspension date.

This Houston MSAT Relocation Grant is provided to students who are currently enrolled in a program, or previously graduated from a program at a Universal Technical Institute campus located outside of Houston, TX or NASCAR Technical Institute, who desire to further their education by enrolling in one of the MSAT programs listed above at the Universal Technical Institute campus in Houston, TX.

The Houston MSAT Relocation Grant Application is a required form in the application process. All applicants completing this form will receive email notification from the UTI Scholarship Department notifying them of the outcome of the grant. Upon approval, all eligible applicants will be contacted by their Student Development Advisor from Universal Technical Institute in Houston, TX.

The Houston MSAT Relocation Grant will only be available for students utilizing Collegiate Housing Services and will cover the applicant's Service Fee, Deposit (if applicable) and rent for the basic shared housing unit for the duration of the program, not to exceed 15 weeks. With the exception of the \$100 check provided to Student, these funds will be paid by UTI directly to Collegiate Housing Services. Student is responsible for the Application Fee.

This grant cannot be used in conjunction with any other internal UTI Scholarship, grant or tuition reduction that UTI, Inc. offers during the enrollment to Universal Technical Institute located in Houston, TX (such as the Industry's Choice Scholarship, Salute to Service Grant or Elective Scholarship). Only one award will be given per student.

If a student fails to graduate with the required GPA, changes start date or campus, his/her grant may be forfeited. Any grants awarded are not transferable to any other person.
