NASCAR Technical Institute
Scholarship Amount: \$3,500

Objective:

In an effort to further its Diversity, NASCAR is sponsoring a scholarship program for incoming students exclusively at the NASCAR Technical Institute campus. Students who feel they can create positive change in the racing industry through advancement of diversity initiatives are encouraged to apply.

Criteria for awarding the scholarship:

This scholarship program is available for enrolled students who meet all other admissions requirements for NASCAR Technical Institute. In addition, all applicants must meet all of the criteria outlined below to be eligible to apply.

Students must:

- Be enrolled to begin training at the NASCAR Technical Institute campus.
- Reflect financial need based on information provided by a completed FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). For questions on the completion or approval of your FAFSA, call your campus Financial Aid Department.
- Clearly express how he/she will contribute to the furthering of diversity and how this initiative will benefit racing
- Submit the application to the Scholarship Department by the deadline for each start date outlined in the chart below

Process and Rules:

Students must complete an application and essay and submit them to the UTI Scholarship Department. For all applicants, the deadline for receipt of the application is based on each applicant's start date. All approved start dates and coinciding deadlines are listed in the chart provided. **This scholarship is ONLY available to incoming students who are enrolled to attend the NASCAR Technical Institute. Students already attending classes at NASCAR Technical Institute are ineligible to apply.** All applications are due to the Scholarship Department no later than the deadline provided for the applicant's start date. All eligible applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarship Committee, and up to one eligible applicant will be awarded for each eligible start date.

This scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other internal UTI tuition reduction program (i.e. Salute To Service Scholarship). Only one award of this scholarship will be given per student. Students must complete an application and essay, and submit them to the UTI Scholarship Department. The applications received will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Students who apply and meet all requirements will be considered for this scholarship.

Of those viable applications, the awards will be distributed to those students who present financial need as well as those who most clearly and adequately answer the essay question provided: **"How you, as a student, could further NASCAR's Diversity Initiative? How could furthering diversity in motor sports benefit NASCAR?"** All viable applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarship Committee. Students must be enrolled to attend NASCAR Technical Institute at the time of the application submission. Scholarships awarded are not transferable to any other person. If a student changes start dates, his/her scholarship may be forfeited. If a student chooses not to attend NASCAR Technical Institute or after beginning his/her program chooses to leave for any reason (withdrawal, suspended, terminated), he/she will forfeit the NASCAR Diversity Scholarship. All scholarships granted through the NASCAR Diversity Scholarship Program can only be used during the initial enrollment; any unutilized funds cannot be applied to a secondary enrollment.

Funding for this program is limited and the program may be suspended at any time at UTI's discretion. Such a suspension will not affect awards to students who are awarded a scholarship under this program prior to the suspension date.

This program is NOT available to any student attending the Exton, PA campus of UTI due to state regulations.
