NASCAR Technical Institute
Scholarship Amount: \$2,500

Objective:

NASCAR is looking for the perfect blend of technical skills and attitude, just like every employer of NASCAR Technical Institute's graduates. This program, sponsored by NASCAR, seeks to assist students with financial need who are looking for great career training with NASCAR Technical Institute, and who truly understand and exhibit the traits of a great team member.

Criteria for awarding the scholarship:

This scholarship program is available for enrolled students who meet all other admissions requirements for NASCAR Technical Institute. In addition, all applicants must meet all of the criteria outlined below to be eligible to apply.

Students must:

- Be enrolled to begin training at the NASCAR Technical Institute campus.
- Reflect financial need based on information provided by a completed FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). For questions on the completion or approval of your FAFSA, call your campus Financial Aid Department.
- Submit the application to the Scholarship Department by the deadline for each start date outlined in the chart below

Process and Rules:

Students must complete an application and essay and submit them to the UTI Scholarship Department. For all applicants, the deadline for receipt of the application is based on each applicant's start date. All approved start dates and coinciding deadlines are listed in the chart provided. All eligible applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarship Committee, and up to two applicants will be awarded per approved start date. **This scholarship is ONLY available to incoming students who are enrolled to attend the NASCAR Technical Institute. Students already attending classes at NASCAR Technical Institute are ineligible to apply.** All applications are due to the Scholarship Department no later than the deadline provided for the applicant's start date. All eligible applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarship Committee, and up to two eligible applicants will be awarded for each eligible start date.

This scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other internal UTI tuition reduction program (i.e. Salute to Service). Only one award of this scholarship will be given per student. Students must complete an application and essay, and submit them to the UTI Scholarship Department. The applications received will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Students who apply and meet all requirements will be considered for this scholarship.

Of those viable applications, the awards will be distributed to those students who present financial need as well as those who most clearly and adequately answer the essay question provided: **"What are the skills and personality traits needed to make a great NASCAR team? How do you exhibit those traits? How would this scholarship help you to develop those skills and traits for a successful career as an automotive technician?"** All viable applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarship Committee. Students must be enrolled to attend NASCAR Technical Institute at the time of the application submission. Scholarships awarded are not transferable to any other person. If a student changes start dates, his/her scholarship may be forfeited. If a student chooses not to attend NASCAR Technical Institute or after beginning his/her program chooses to leave for any reason (withdrawal, suspended, terminated), he/she will forfeit the NASCAR Technician of Tomorrow Scholarship. All scholarships granted through the NASCAR Technician of Tomorrow Scholarship Program can only be used during the initial enrollment; any unutilized funds cannot be applied to a secondary enrollment.
