



## UTI Housing Grant Program 2016-2017

### Universal Technical Institute/NASCAR Technical Institute Motorcycle and Marine Mechanics Institute Information Sheet

**Objective:**

To provide grants for housing costs incurred through Collegiate Housing Services by relocating students enrolled at \*UTI/MMI/NASCAR Technical Institute, who show financial need and who reflect a true commitment to converting their passion into a career as a professional technician (based on the criteria outlined below). The grant will support enrolled relocating students with the greatest financial need who face a hardship starting their education. This grant will only be available for the shared occupancy option for housing through Collegiate Housing Services and will cover a portion of the initial cost of housing, specifically: the first month's rent. Award amount not to exceed \$689.00. The first month's rent does not cover any pro-rated rent amounts based on move-in date. Student is responsible for any pro-rated amounts based on move-in date, service fee and application fee.

**Criteria for awarding the scholarship:**

Enrolled relocating students who meet all other admissions requirements for Universal Technical Institute, NASCAR Technical Institute, Motorcycle Mechanics Institute or Marine Mechanics Institute, and all the criteria below, may apply for the UTI Housing Grant.

**Students must:**

- Be enrolled to begin training at an \*UTI/MMI/NASCAR Technical Institute campus for one of the start dates outlined below.
- Reflect financial need based on information provided by a completed FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). For questions on the completion or approval of your FAFSA, call your campus Financial Aid Department.
- Participate in the shared occupancy option for housing through Collegiate Housing Services.
- Submit the application to the Scholarship Department by the deadline for each Start Date outlined in the chart provided.

**Process and Rules:** This program is available starting October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.

Students must complete an application and submit it to the UTI Scholarship Department. For all applicants, the final deadline for receipt of this application is posted on the chart provided. All eligible applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarship Committee, and all applicants will be notified within one week following the deadline. **This grant is ONLY available to incoming students. Students already attending classes are ineligible to apply.** Applications may be submitted to the Scholarship Department any time after applicants FAFSA has been completed, but must be submitted by the deadline posted in the chart provided.

**Program Disclaimers:**

This grant cannot be used in conjunction with any other internal UTI scholarship or tuition reduction (i.e. Industry's Choice Scholarship, Salute to Service scholarship, Imagine America, CCST, etc.). Only one award of this grant will be given per student. Students must complete an application and submit it to the UTI Scholarship Department. The applications received will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Students who apply and meet all requirements will be considered for this grant.

Of those viable applications, the awards will be distributed on a first come, first serve basis. All viable applications will be reviewed by the UTI Scholarship Committee. Grants are based on start dates and there are a limited amount of awards per start date. \*Students must be enrolled to attend Universal Technical Institute, NASCAR Technical Institute, Motorcycle Mechanics Institute, or Motorcycle and Marine Mechanics Institute at the time of application submission. Grants awarded are not transferable to any other person. If a student changes their start date after receiving the UTI Housing Grant, his/her grant may be forfeited. All awards granted through the UTI Housing Grant Program can only be used during the initial enrollment; any unutilized funds cannot be applied to a secondary enrollment.

Award amount not to exceed \$689.00. The first month's rent does not cover any pro-rated rent amounts based on move-in date. These funds will be paid directly to Collegiate Housing Services after move in. Student is responsible for any pro-rated amounts based on move-in date, service fee and application fee.

This grant cannot be used in conjunction with any other internal UTI scholarship or tuition reduction that UTI, Inc. offers (such as the Industry's Choice Scholarship, Salute to Service Scholarship, Imagine America, CCST, etc.). Only one award will be given per student. If you have applied and are determined to be eligible for an Internal Scholarship and the UTI Housing Grant, please choose which one you would like to accept.
