



Long Beach MSAT Relocation Grant 2015-2016

Universal Technical Institute Information Sheet

Objective:

To provide grants for housing costs incurred through Collegiate Housing Services by students who are attending Universal Technical Institute in Sacramento, CA that are required to relocate to the Long Beach, CA campus due to the relocation of the NATT MSAT program. The grant will support enrolled relocating students who meet the criteria outlined below. This grant will only be available for the shared bedroom option within the shared occupancy program for housing through Collegiate Housing Services and will cover the applicant's rent for a ten (10) week period. Award amount not to exceed \$700.00 a month. Student is responsible for any fees not associated with monthly rent expenses, such as deposit fee, application fee, etc.

Criteria for awarding the scholarship:

This Grant in Aid is available to applicants who are currently attending, or scheduled to attend Universal Technical Institute in Sacramento, CA and are actively enrolled in the NATT MSAT program prior to April 27, 2015. In addition, all applicants must meet all of the criteria outlined below to be eligible to apply.

Students must:

- Be currently enrolled at Universal Technical Institute in Sacramento, CA.
- Be a current or Future student who was actively enrolled in the NATT MSAT program prior to April 27, 2015 and be required to relocate to Universal Technical Institute in Long Beach, CA in order to complete the NATT MSAT portion of their program.
- Be eligible to participate in a shared bedroom option within the shared occupancy program for housing through Collegiate Housing Services.
- Submit the application to the Scholarship Department by July 31, 2015.
- Be scheduled to graduate from their core program and begin the NATT MSAT program no later than December 2016.
- Have a GPA of 2.0 or higher on their 1st (or previous) enrollment with Universal Technical Institute.

Application Process: The Long Beach MSAT Relocation Grant is a dual step application process. Applicants will be required to complete the Long Beach MSAT Relocation Grant Application Form (A) as the first step in the application process. The submission **deadline for Form (A) will be July 31, 2015.** Upon approval for the grant, each applicant will receive the Long Beach MSAT Relocation Grant Form (B) to complete. The **submission deadline for Form (B) will be one month prior to graduation from the Sacramento, CA campus.** It is the responsibility of each applicant to coordinate the necessary time needed to sit down with their Student Development Advisor to complete Form (B). The UTI Scholarship Department will be responsible for notating each eligible applicant's file with the necessary comments needed for the campus to verify eligibility for the Long Beach MSAT Relocation Grant.

Process and Rules:

Information about this grant is posted on the UTI website (www.uti.edu).

This grant cannot be used in conjunction with any other internal UTI scholarship or tuition reduction during enrollment to the Universal Technical Institute campus located in Sacramento, CA (i.e. Industry's Choice Scholarship, Military Tuition Reduction). Only one award will be given per student. Students will complete an application and submit it to the Scholarship Department. The applications received will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Students who apply and meet all requirements will be considered for this grant, which is paid directly to Collegiate Housing Services and is applied toward the student's housing costs.

Of those viable applications, the awards will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. If a student changes start dates or campus, his/her grant may be forfeited. Any grants awarded are not transferable to any other person. If a student chooses not to attend Universal Technical Institute in Sacramento, CA or after beginning their program chooses to leave for any reason (withdrawal, suspended, terminated), they will forfeit the Long Beach MSAT Relocation Grant.

Grants shall not be used as a recruiting device. Funding for this program is limited and the program may be suspended at any time at UTI's discretion. Such a suspension will not affect awards to students who are awarded a grant under this program prior to the suspension date.

This Long Beach MSAT Relocation Grant Application (A) form is a required form in a dual step application process. All applicants completing this form will receive email notification from the UTI Scholarship Department notifying them of the outcome of the grant. Upon approval, all eligible applicants will be required to complete Form (B) in order to complete the application process.

The Long Beach MSAT Relocation Grant will only be available for the shared bedroom option within the shared occupancy program available through Collegiate Housing Services and will cover the applicants rent for a ten (10) week period. Award amount not to exceed \$700.00 a month. These funds will be paid by UTI directly to Collegiate Housing Services after move in. Student is responsible for any fees not associated with the monthly rent, such as deposit fee, application fee, etc.

This grant cannot be used in conjunction with any other internal UTI scholarship or tuition reduction that UTI, Inc. offers during enrollment to Universal Technical Institute located in Long Beach, CA (such as the Industry's Choice Scholarship or Salute to Service Scholarship). Only one award will be given per student.
