



## UTI Institutional Grant Universal Technical Institute Information Sheet

### **Objective:**

To provide institutional grants for students who are attending Universal Technical Institute (*except the UTI Exton campus*), NASCAR Technical Institute, Motorcycle Mechanics Institute and Marine Mechanics Institute campuses with demonstrated financial need (as defined by the criteria outlined below). The grant will be awarded to all students who meet the eligibility criteria; there is no separate application process. (This grant is not available for students enrolled in the CNC or Welding programs.) This grant is effective August 2017 and will be in effect for the start dates listed at the following campuses:

### **Criteria for awarding the scholarship:**

Eligibility will be based on proximity to the campus and financial need as determined by the Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) calculated by the US Dept of Education as a result of a student completing their FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). Students who have an EFC of \$3,000 or less, and whose initial address provided to the school is at least 50 miles from their attending campus will be eligible for the grant.

### **Eligibility details:**

- If a student cancels or postpones out of the eligible start dates they will forfeit the grant they were awarded or would have otherwise been eligible for.
- Students that receive this grant **will** maintain eligibility for any other UTI grants, scholarships or tuition discounts they have received or would otherwise be eligible to receive.
- A student's eligibility will be based on any valid ISIR that is on file for the 2016/2017 year or later.
- Note, if more than one valid ISIR is on file the student will receive the grant based on the lowest EFC.
- A student's proximity to the campus will be based on the address provided at the time the student initially provided their information to the school.
- Students enrolled in CNC or Welding programs are not eligible for this grant.

### **Process and Rules:**

Information about this grant is posted on the UTI website ([www.uti.edu](http://www.uti.edu)).

Only one award will be given per student.

Any grants awarded are not transferable to any other person.

This grant will be applied as a credit against tuition and will not be issued to the student in the form of cash.
